

COVID19 Safety - Instructions to King's Church Eden Attendees

- If you are or any member of your family/bubble are symptomatic as defined by the NHS, please do not attend any meetings. See attached link for details.

- Please follow government guidelines on self-isolation after positive tests or if required to do so by Track and Trace notification.
- People who are “clinically extremely vulnerable” to COVID19 and/or over 70yrs are advised by the government not to attend public meetings in person. Meetings will be available online.
- You will need to book in advance if you would like to come along. You can do this by using the Eventbrite booking system. [Eventbrite](#) (Note – we will need to hold your data for 21 days for track and trace purposes as per COVID19 data protection policy).
- You must use hand sanitizer or wash hands on entering URC building and when using toilet facilities.
- It is mandatory for anyone over 11 years to wear a facemask whilst attending meetings unless you are exempt for medical purposes, in which case please wear your exemption lanyard or ask a member of the welcome team for one.
- Please respect social distancing measures when moving within, entering and exiting the building, following direction signs and instructions as required. When arriving and leaving please avoid gathering in groups, and maintain 2m social distancing.
- Unfortunately, the layout of the URC sanctuary and limited space in the foyer does not allow room for us to sit or meet in groups of six from different households. This does not affect families or bubbles sitting together in their designated seats.
- As things currently stand, singing will not form part of our worship, except for the worship team. Spoken contributions must be shared via the microphone provided.

COVID19 Safety - Good Practice

- Please follow and do not move the designated seating signs or distance markers.
- Please remain in your designated seats, where possible, during the meeting, except for bringing contributions or using the toilets.
- Please could parent/guardian accompany children under 10 to the washroom to assist with hand washing.
- Refreshments will not be served and there will not be a coffee break during meetings (if you bring your own please do so safely and take all containers and rubbish away with you).
- Please be careful to take all personal belongings away with you.
- Unless you are exempt, please keep your facemask on at all times whilst in the building, except when bringing a contribution from the microphone.
- People will be asked to leave the building in a staggered way to help to avoid bottlenecks.
